SERVICES

The Outpatient Program offers the following broad spectrum of services.

Individual Counseling – Allows you to meet one-on-one with a qualified therapist to work on short-term problems. Focus of such sessions can include improving self-esteem, adjusting to divorce, dealing with trauma, grief or depression.

Group Counseling – Provides the opportunity to meet with a therapist who helps groups of individuals with similar problems. Group can be effective for dealing with anger control, addictive disorders and socialization problems.



Family Counseling – Focuses on relationship issues, including marriage enrichment, resolving marital conflicts or strengthening family relationships. Conflicting parent/child roles are often best addressed in family counseling sessions.

Psychiatric Services – Provided by a physician licensed to prescribe medication and trained in detection, diagnosis and treatment of emotional problems.

SERVICES

Testing services help evaluate learning disabilities and some emotional problems.

Case Management provides assistance to access community resources and help put skills learned in therapy to practical day-to-day use, through supportive outreach.

Educational Programs are offered at our offices and to community groups. Topics include: positive parenting, assertiveness, stress management, holiday depression, and management of assaultive behavior.

CHILDREN AND ADOLESCENTS

Children and teenagers are served at all our clinic locations, except for Springhill. We recognize that families are crucial in each child's life, and that good evaluation and treatment cannot occur unless parents and other important adults are part of the treatment team.



PCA is the "lead agency" for CASSP - (Child and Adolescent Service System Program) in Lonoke, Prairie, and North Pulaski Counties. For children with severe emotional disturbances, or children with emotional problems whose needs require services from several different agencies or State departments, PCA arranges a multi-agency staffing to coordinate services.

The following services are available to children, adolescents and their families:

- ✓ **School-Based Services** are available in public schools and some daycare settings.
- ✓ **Children's Case Management** is available at all our clinics.

- ✓ **Wrap Around Services** focus on building natural support for youth and families.
- ✓ **In Lonoke County our PROMOTE program** serves youth who are at-risk or involved with the Division of Youth Services.

- ❖ Offices open from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. **Monday through Friday.**
